In all of the sessions, a common goal is to improve the relationship you have with your dog by developing *trust, confidence, and respect*.

All of the courses are appropriate if you are seeking to improve your relationship or if you are trying to solve problem behaviors. You may choose to take one, or all, depending on your personal goals.

### Marker Training

Fun for you and your dog while building a strong relationship. Marker Trainer encourages your dog to *offer* desirable behaviors. It is a great way to improve obedience, learn tricks, and to develop engagement. Your dog will *want* to please you!

### Obedience

An understanding of basic obedience is an important tool for any dog and owner. We focus on helping dogs and their owners in a manner that is appropriate for them; not all dogs are alike, and not all owners are alike. We will help you discover what motivates your dog and show you how you can use that to establish a healthy relationship with your dog. A good foundation in obedience can also help prevent problem behaviors, or help to change undesirable behaviors that have developed.

Examples of things you may work on: sit, down, wait, heel, walk on a loose leash, leave it

### House Manners

A dog that has manners is so much easier to have around and to enjoy! You don't have to accept undesirable behaviors! A dog that understands boundaries and rules is much more content dog than one that "runs of the house." We want to help optimize the relationship you have with the four-legged member of your family!

Examples of things you may work on: Place Bed command, not jumping on people, waiting at the doors, waiting for food, quiet/chill time, crate training/crate games, leave it

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### Name Recognition/Recalls

Perhaps one of the most important components in the relationship we have with our dogs. The ability to call your dog from any distraction, in any environment, enables you to give him more freedom and to ensure his safety.

### Open Practice
